Guidelines for project applications

1. The aim of the project (Maximum 300 words)

Explain the objective of the project, what you want to achieve and who will be the beneficiaries of the project.

2. The justification (maximum 750 words)

Why is the project important? Describe the current situation in your country on public health and participation issues? How will your project improve the participation of NGOs in decision – making bodies in national and EU level? How is your organisation able to involve a range of other NGOs in the project?

3. The activities of the project (maximum 750 words)

What do you plan to do and how will these activities meet the aim of the project?

4. The results of the project (maximum 750 words)

What impact will the project have, particularly for the project beneficiaries?

5. What will be the sustainability of the project (maximum 750 words)

How will things be different after the project?

6. Introducing the applicant (maximum 750 words)

Present your organisation, covering the objectives and membership, activities and any projects implemented over the last two years.

7. The budget

Use the excel form to set out the details of the proposed costs for the project. You should clearly indicate the cost breakdown between the applicant and the requested funds from EPHA.

8. Enclose CV of people responsible for the project
